Iconography

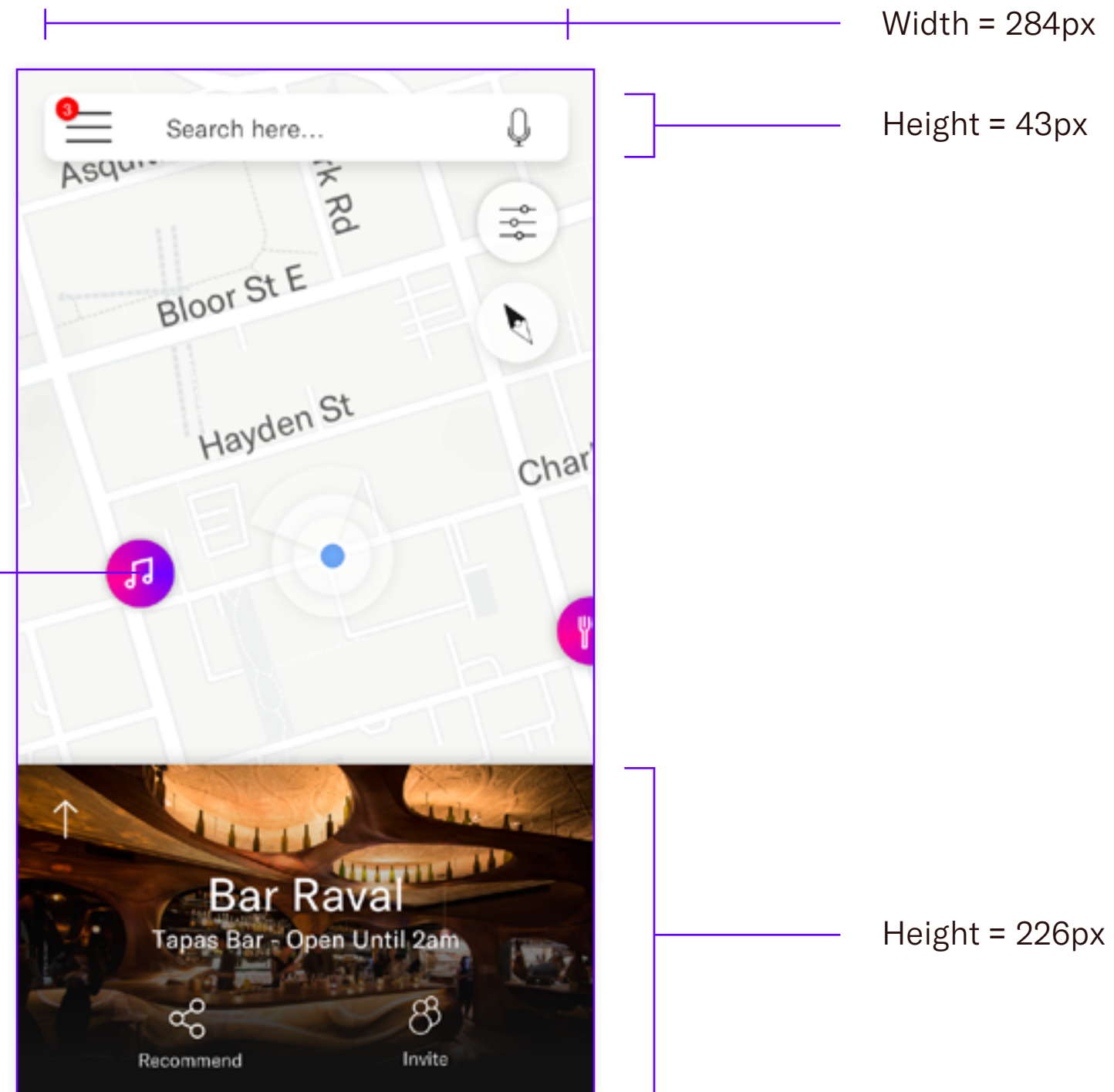

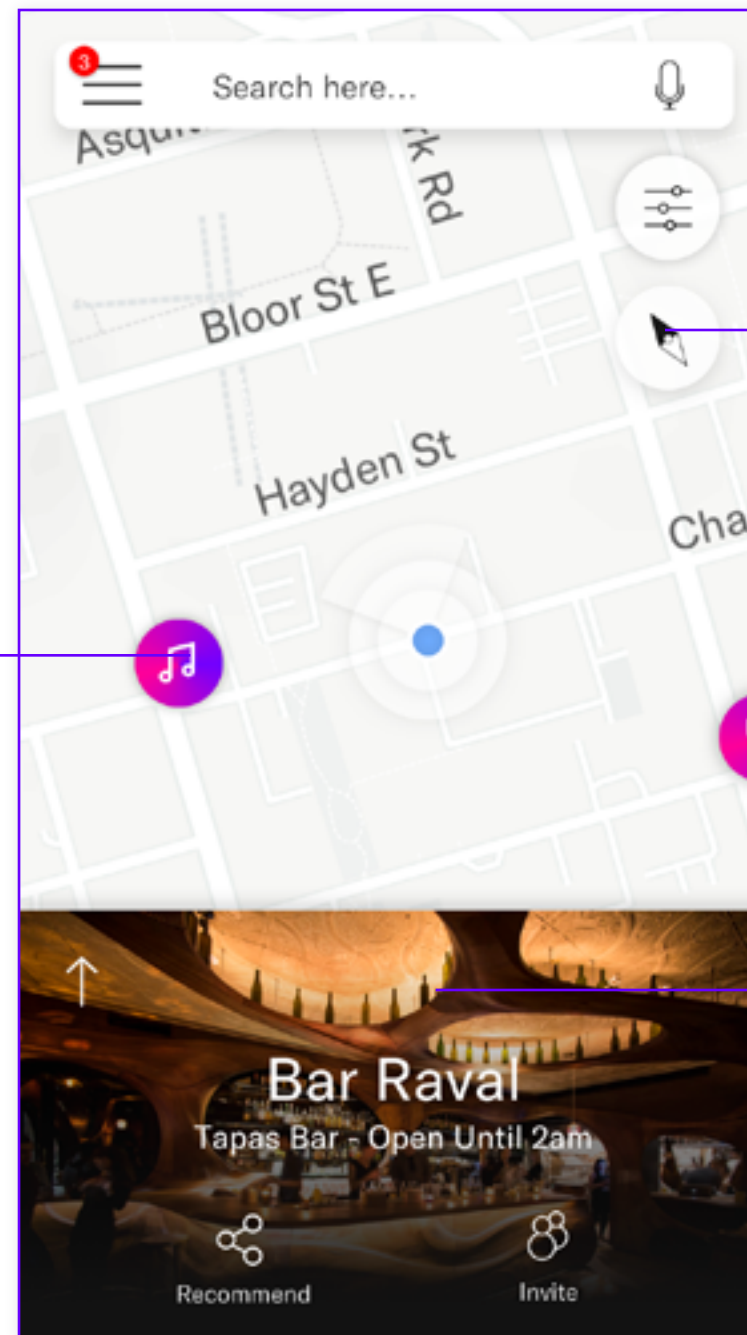
Icon is coloured and pushes when the location is open



Interaction

Tap and Zoom

Tapping on a location icon will reveal the location details preview as well as zoom in on the most direct path to the desired location.



Tap and Respond

Tapping the location tracking icon will automatically place the user in the center of the screen based on their current location.

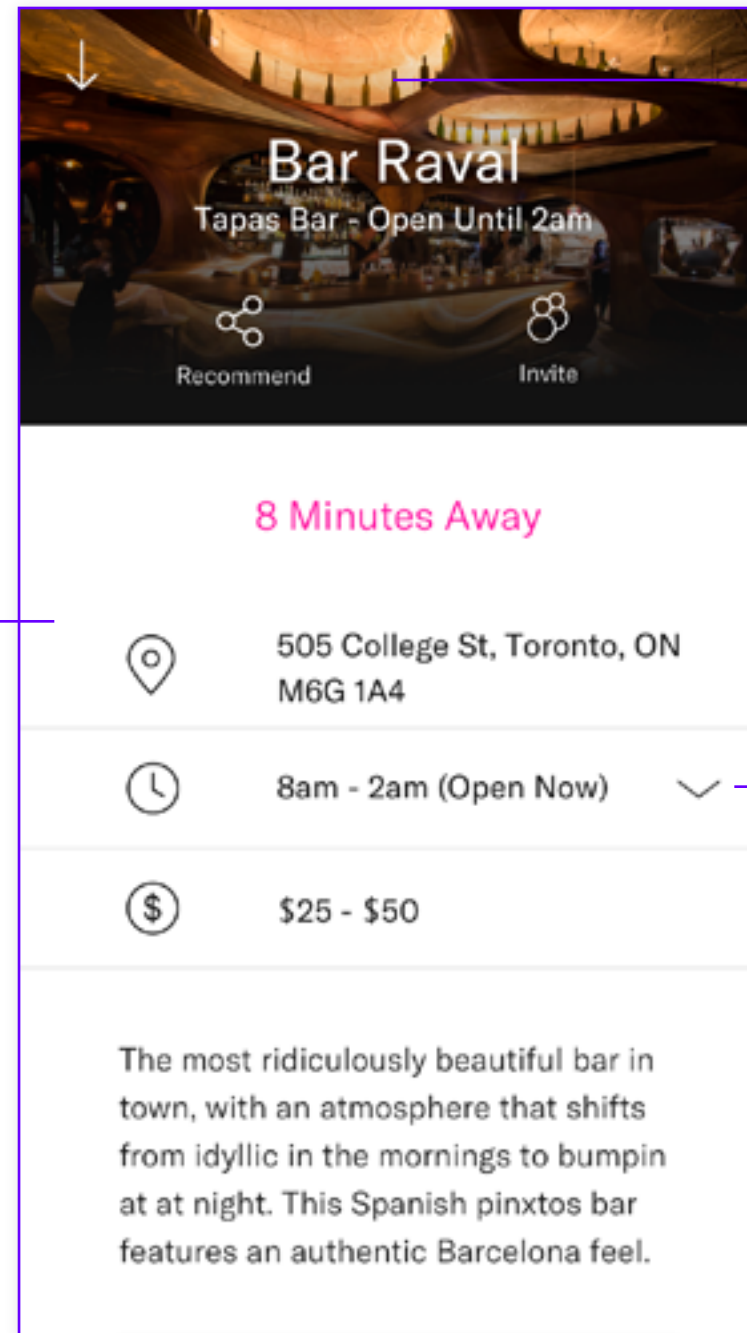
Swiping Actions

Swiping up on the location detail preview will reveal the full location details page.

Interaction

Sliding Details

Swiping up and down through the main content will allow you to view more details about the selected location



Swipe Back

Swiping down on the location details page header to take you back to the main menu.

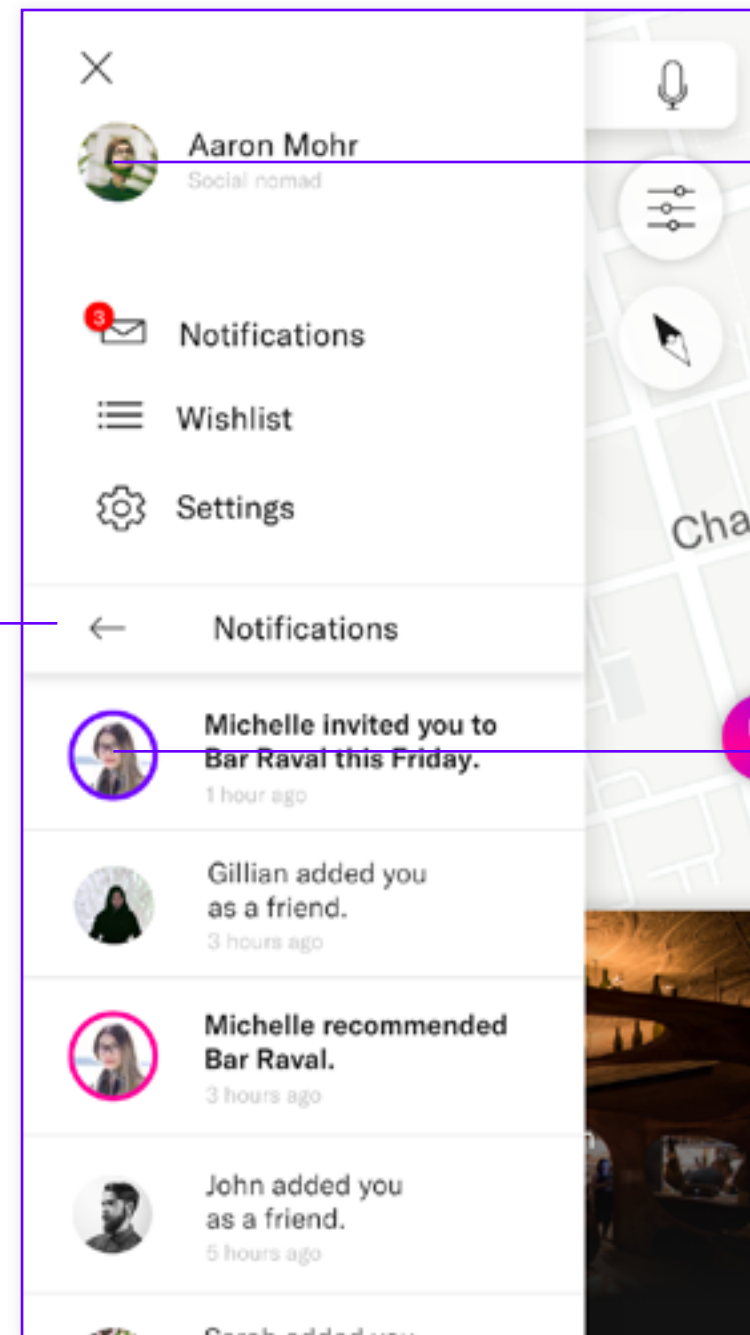
Weekly Hours

Tapping on your user icon will guide you to your user profile where you can access your contact list and view past history.

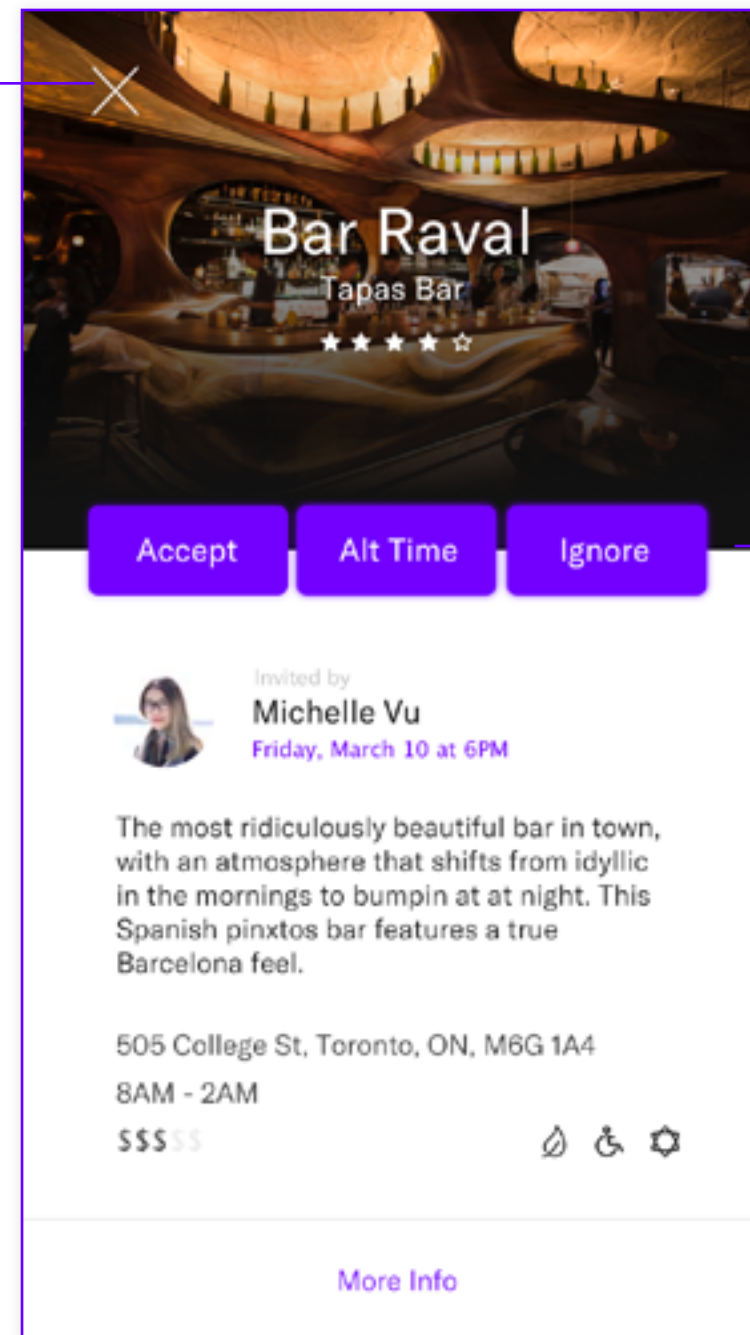
Manage Notifications
